These tactics will be useful for other movements.

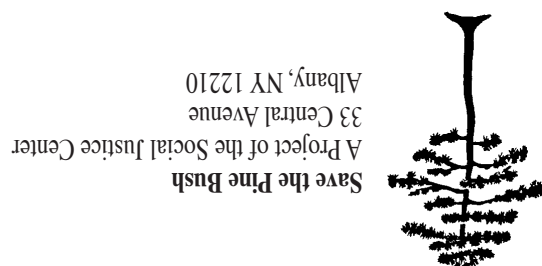
